The enclosed Volume 10 of the Exhibits to Southern California Gas Company's ("SoCalGas") Petition for Writ of Review, Mandate, and/or Other Appropriate Relief is being filed <u>conditionally under seal</u> pursuant to an Application for Leave to File Under Seal.

Redacted versions of the exhibits in Volume 10 (exhibits 62–65) can be located at App. 371–384. In addition, redacted versions of the exhibits in Volume 9 (exhibits 56–61) can be located at App. 167–286, 355–356, 362, 365, and 368–369.

As explained in that Application, SoCalGas's position is that its constitutional rights will be severely prejudiced if the Volume 10 exhibits are disclosed to Respondent California Public Advocates Office ("CalPA"). For that reason, SoCalGas has not submitted Volume 10 through the TrueFiling system, which would automatically give CalPA access to those highly sensitive SoCalGas materials. Instead, because SoCalGas seeks by its sealing application to avoid disclosure of the Volume 10 exhibits to

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CalPA (in addition to the public), SoCalGas submits Volume 10 directly to the Court, as instructed by one of your colleagues on Friday.
