Amicus curiae letter in support of petition for writ of review, mandate, and/or other appropriate relief

Honorable Justices,

San Diego Gas & Electric Company ("SDG&E") respectfully urges this Court to grant the stay and petition for review in this case. As explained in the writ petition, the California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC") has issued orders infringing upon the constitutional rights of an investor-owned utility ("IOU"),¹ including rights under the First and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution and Article I of the California Constitution. The issued orders are based on a broad interpretation of the discovery rights of the Public Advocates Office ("CalPA"), a separate organization within the CPUC. Accordingly, the issues at stake may have broader implications for other IOUs and regulated entities in California, including SDG&E.

SDG&E understands and deeply respects the regulatory authority possessed by the CPUC and CalPA, including authority to inspect IOU documents. Such authority, however, is not

unlimited. In this case, it is concerning that CalPA is seeking to use its limited authority to pursue goals beyond its statutory mandate and in a manner that infringes upon IOU First Amendment rights. That the CPUC would approve of CalPA's tactics is equally if not more troubling. In particular, SDG&E is troubled by that part of the CPUC order putting third parties who associate with an IOU on notice that their contacts are subject to discovery. Given the nature of these issues, including the need for more clarity in the law around the rights of IOUs to use shareholder (i.e., non-ratepayer) funds to support First Amendment activity without fear of discovery or interference, SDG&E respectfully requests guidance from this Court.
